



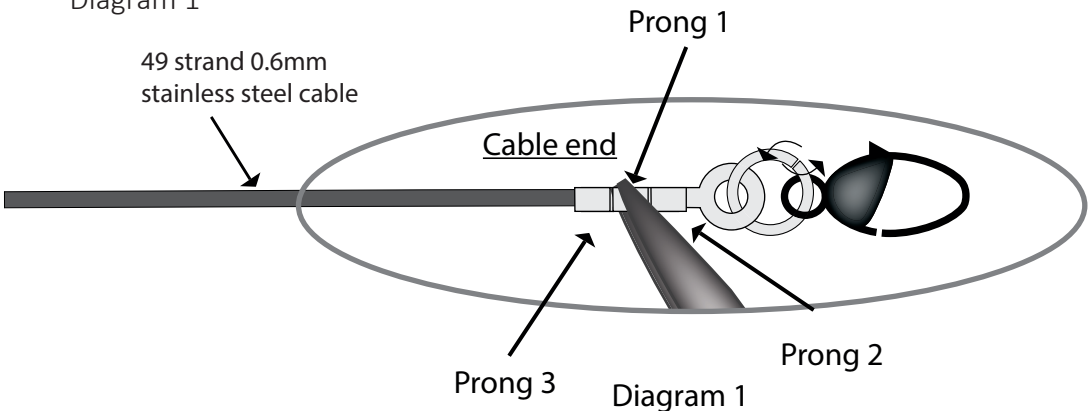
Works with 0.45mm and 0.6mm diameter cable

Finishing off a necklace or bracelet (attaching ends and a catch) is just as important as the arrangement of beads.

The Cable End is a neat and professional component to finish Cable Style necklaces.

1. Slide each of the raw cable ends into the cable end fitting;
2. Using Chain Nose pliers fold the prongs loosely over the Cable.
3. Adjust the cable position within the fittings as required; nudge the prongs from the sides and then squeezing the top and bottom to create a firm attachment evenly around the Cable. A final squeeze across the top and bottom for super security if necessary.

4. At the 'clasp end' of your necklace, open up a small jump ring with your pliers and slide it onto your end fitting.
5. Now add your catch into the open jump ring as well.
6. Close the jump ring using pliers. Your clasp is now secured to your end fitting.
7. At the 'ring end' of your necklace, open up a large jump ring and slide it onto your end fitting.
8. Close the large jump ring using pliers. This now becomes the ring into which your clasp will fasten to secure your necklace for wearing.
