
Diamond-Cut Ball Chain 0.8mm can be <u>crimped onto</u>, or used as a traditional chain to hang a pendant from. The diamond cut balls add an extra dimension and twinkle as the chain moves. Light in weight, this fine chain is beautiful, and results in exquisite jewellery.

1. <u>To crimp onto ball chain use 1.8mm Bead Crimp</u>. Using chain nose pliers squeeze one of the 1.8mm bead crimps with the tip of the chain nose pliers gently, until you feel the chain resisting underneath. Remove pliers to check work, if the crimp is not sitting firmly give another very gentle squeeze. Squeeze a 1.8mm crimp bead, into place on the other side of your bead, so your beads are held secure. 2. Use Cable Ends (single strand) with Diamond Cut - ball chain to finish off the necklace/bracelet. Place the Diamond cut ball chain into the sleeve of the Cable end; Using Chain Nose pliers fold prong 1 first and then prong 2. Prong 3 should be nudged gently into position, so not to push the chain out of line. Nudging the prongs from the sides and then squeezing the top and bottom to create a final firm attachment if necessary.

Attach a Jump ring and a catch, to the eye of the Cable end. Attach a further cable end and jump ring to the other end of your chain. Diagram 1
